

Duty to provide information in the event of the collection of data from the data subject pursuant to Art. 13 GDPR

We hereby inform you about the processing of your personal data by Weier Antriebe und Energietechnik GmbH and the rights to which you are entitled under data protection law.

Who is responsible for data processing and who is the data protection officer?

Which categories of data do we use?

The processed categories primarily include company specific data such as contact persons, names, addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses, website, etc. as well as data on business processes (enquiries, orders, order confirmations, contracts, invoices, correspondence, etc.) which are necessary in the course of proper business transactions.

Legal basis of the processing:

Your data will be processed on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 sen. 1 lit. b GDPR.

Who is the recipient of your data?

Within our company, only employees who are entrusted with the handling of the business process have access to the data. They are not made available to third parties.

What data protection rights can you assert as a data subject?

You can request **information** about the personal data stored about you at the above address. In addition, under certain circumstances you can request the **correction** or **erasure** of your data. You may also **have the right to restrict the processing** of

your data and **the right to have the data provided by you to be handed over** in a structured, common and machine-readable format.

Right to objection to the processing of personal data which is carried out on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR

If we process your data for the purpose of legitimate interests, you may object to this processing for reasons arising from your particular situation. We will then no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Where can you complain?

You have the option of complaining to the above-mentioned data protection officer or to a data protection supervisory authority.

How long will your data be stored?

We will erase your personal data as soon as it is no longer required for the above mentioned purposes. At this end, it may be necessary for personal data to be retained for the period in which claims can be asserted against us (statutory limitation period of three or up to thirty years).

Will your data be transferred to a third country?

We do not transfer any personal data to third parties outside the European Economic Area (EEA).
